

As your child starts their journey at St Joseph's School, you will find that we are encouraging them to take ownership and responsibility for their own learning. Parents/caregivers are

welcomed and encouraged to make contact with staff throughout the year at appropriate times. Teachers are available for contact via email beforeor after schoolhours.

#### **Absences and Lateness**

If your child is absent, please call and leave a message at the school office at (09) 376 5456,

Option 1, or follow the prompts from the school website/app to notify the school office. If you know in advance your child will be away, please email their teacher and the office.

If your child is late, they must provide a note from a parent/caregiver providing an explanation. This needs to be written in their Student Planner. If an explanation is not received for their lateness, it will be recorded, and if there is an ongoing issue,

parents/caregivers will be contacted. If a teacher feels there are too many unexplained late passes, they will be in contact with parents.

#### **Phones at School**

Students can bring their phones to school. They must hand in their phone to their form

teacher before school starts. The phones are locked away in a safe area in the class. Students collect their phones from their class teacher at the end of the day. Phones are not to be used or in the student's possession during school time, with no exceptions.

### **Contacting Teachers**

If you would like to contact your child's teachers, please use the email addresses on our school website. Our teachers are encouraged not to email during teaching time – as your

child's learning is a priority – you can expect a reply within 24 hours of sending the email. It may be longerif the teacher requires time to consultwith the leadership team or other

teachers to give them time to provide the most informed response.

If it is urgent, please contact the office, and a message can be left for the teacher. They will get back to you at the most convenient time. We would like your child to become increasingly independent as they progress through their time at St. Joseph's Grey Lynn.

### **Reporting to Parents**

When reporting orally and in written form to parents/caregivers, the school will endeavour to be open and honest as well as encouraging. Each child is regarded as a unique individual with varying talents and abilities. It is our aim to find each child's potential in whatever field. To achieve this, home and schoolmust work together.
