<p>RE: Easter Helps Christians to Have Hope (Part of the Liturgical Year Module)</p> <p>LI: explain how Easter helps Christians to have hope.</p>	<p>Read about Christian hope, with your family if needed.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Christian hope is a confidence that something will happen because God has promised it will happen.</li> <li>2) Christian hope is about the present, (today) and the future, (what lies ahead of us).</li> <li>3) Christian hope means that no matter how bad things get, God will never forget his people and will always be with them.</li> </ol> <p>Think of a time when you have been scared or anxious. Write a prayer asking God to give you hope for the future.
