

Perhaps you will show the women as they arrive to find the angel, or draw them meeting Jesus on the way home.</p> <p>You may prefer to make a diagram of the empty tomb from an old cardboard box. You could include the risen Jesus, or the angel talking to the women.</p> 	<p>The story of The Resurrection doesn't just celebrate that Jesus rose from the dead. Christians also celebrate His promise to share that eternal life with us.</p> <p>Set up a prayer focus in your home to celebrate The Resurrection. Include your drawing or diagram. If you can find a cloth in the Easter colours of white or yellow, use that too. Say a prayer thanking God for the gift of The Resurrection and the new life given to us through Jesus.</p>
