

<p>RE: What is the Fruit of the Spirit? (Part of the Holy Spirit Module)</p> <p>LI: name the three persons of the Holy Trinity in English and Maori</p>	<p>Read: The Holy Spirit is the third person in the Trinity - the idea of God as three persons in one: <i>God the Father / Te Atua, God the Son (Jesus) / Te Tamaiti and God the Holy Spirit / Te Wairua Tapu.</i></p> <p>Think of the Holy Spirit as part of the Trinity when we make the sign of the cross.</p> <p>Make the Sign of the Cross in English or Maori. Ask the Holy Spirit to bless your home and family at this time. Finish with the Sign of the Cross again.</p>	<p>There are many beautiful art images of the Holy Trinity you can find on the internet.</p> <p>Can you find one you'd like to share? Or draw one of your own? Think about why each symbol was chosen for God the Father, for Jesus, and for the Holy Spirit.
